Worker, 25, Killed In Mueller Accident

A 25-year-old Port Huron man was killed in an industrial accident about 9:45 p.m. Tuesday at the Meuller Brass Co.

Michael D. Waun, of 419 Sixteenth Street, an employee in the rod mill, was dead on arrival at Port Huron Hospital.

Waun is the second industrial fatality for Meuller Brass in the last 28 days.

Wilfred H. Plain, 27, Sarnia, was crushed to death in a sand mixing machine at Meuller Brass on March 31.

Roland G. Krupp, executive vice president, said Waun was working in the rod mill when the accident occurred.

Waun was working on an extrusion press when its steel tip fragmented, Mr. Krupp said.

Patrolman Richard Klaus said the steel block blew out of the machine and struck Waun in the head.

Pieces of the block flew more than 100 feet across the rod mill room and struck the instrumental panel of the No. 4 press.

Patrolman Klaus said Waun was taken by ambulance to the company infirmary and transferred to Port Huron Hospital.

Mr. Krupp said Waun had been employed at Meuller Brass since Aug. 21, 1967 and had worked on a press for two years.

Mr. Krupp said a full investigation of the accident would be conducted by the company.

Mr. Waun was a 1963 graduate of Port Huron High School. He served four years in the Marine Corps. He had been employed at Meuller since 1967. He was attending St. Clair County Community College at the time of his death.

He was born Oct. 2, 1945 in Port Huron. He married Kathyllen Uresti July 12, 1969, in Port Huron.

He is survived by his widow; a daughter, Denise Waun; his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Arthur Waun, Port Huron; a sister, Mrs. Richard McCullough, Warren; and his grandmother, Mrs. John Cornwell, Port Huron.

The Remains will be in Arthur Smith Funeral Home until 11 a.m. Friday when they will be removed to Washington Avenue Methodist Church for services at 1:30 p.m. Burial arrangements are in complete.
