Dear Parent:

The beginning of another school year is rapidly approaching and we, at Port Huron High School, are looking forward to one of the largest tenth grade classes ever to enter. Your son or daughter is expected to be in this group.

We, in the high school, are very much interested in these students and our primary consideration will be their present and future welfare. We will strive to prepare the student to be socially and economically efficient in the home, school and community and to be personally happy as a member of society. As educators we recognize the authority of the parent over the student and are willing to share this responsibility and to cooperate with you for the best interest of your boy or girl.

Enclosed with this letter is a booklet which will acquaint you with some of the policies and services of Port Huron High School. I would suggest that you, as the parent, take time to go over this booklet with your son or daughter so that you may be more familiar with the school in which your boy or girl will be spending seven hours five days a week.

All tenth grade students are expected to be at the school at 8:20 a.m. on Tuesday, September 6. The boys will report to the gymnasium and the girls to the student center. It is important that all students be present and on time because of the group instruction which will be given at this time.

A light lunch will be available at the school on September 6 and 7 at a very nominal cost. Because of the time schedule, there will be only a half hour for lunch on September 6. The cafeteria will open for regular service on Thursday, September 8.

You are invited to visit the school at any time or to call should you desire further information. Your son or daughter is an emerging adult who must achieve independence, but who, in the process must be intelligently and sympathetically helped and guided. This is not always an easy task and it takes full understanding and cooperation among the three parties concerned--the youth, the parents, and the school.
